



## Additional Itinerary Options

### OVERNIGHT RAFTING

Most of our groups find that the one-day rafting excursion on the Pacuare River to be the highlight of the trip. Why not extend this experience to TWO days!? The overnight Pacuare Adventure is a two-day adventure full of paddling and hiking. Not only will you raft more rapids, but you will also have a chance to explore the banks of the great river, hiking to pristine waterfalls and swimming holes in the surrounding primary forests. The first day we will run 13 kms. (8 miles) of continuous class III white water for a total of 14 rapids. We will arrive at the Tent camp in time for lunch. Afternoon activities include various optional hikes, fishing on the river, or simply relaxing in a hammock. The camp, located on the banks of the Pacuare River, offers you modern facilities. The tents are comfortable and spacious set on wooden platforms. There are modern toilets and showers available, and an exotic dining area with plenty of space to chill out with excellent views. The second day of rafting takes us through class III and IV rapids for the distance of 14 miles. This is a special way to experience one of the more pristine areas of Costa Rica.



### MANUEL ANTONIO NATIONAL PARK

Manuel Antonio is Costa Rica's most popular National Park and has some of the most beautiful beaches in the country with dramatic rocky headlands and littoral evergreen forests. The park is 683 hectares with many trails that offer many options to seeing the abundance of wildlife that lives with in the park. Throughout the day we explore the trails and beaches with a delicious picnic lunch on the beach! Manuel Antonio is home to 3 species of monkeys, over 360 species of During our visit to the park we will also learn about the effects of developing tourism in the area. This is a day of hiking, swimming, and relaxing beach time.

### HORSEBACK RIDING AT NAUYUCA

For those of us who love to ride horses, this is the perfect addition to your itinerary. Nauyuca is a private homestead owned by a local family. Their horses are well taken care of and the family feeds us a typical "Tico" lunch on our way out. The waterfall is one of the most stunning waterfalls on the Pacific coast and riding horses to it is only part of the fun. Upon arrival it is safe to swim in the refreshing turquoise pools below. This is a full day trip.

## THE OSA PENINSULA
