



Private Tour Itinerary Example

DAY 1

Arrive in San Jose, Costa Rica and meet your guide. Brian will take you to your hotel so you can get a good nights rest after a long day of travel.

DAY 2

After breakfast we head out on your new adventure. Relax into your seat and enjoy the ride to the central Pacific coast. Our first destination will be Manuel Antonio. On our way we will have lunch. Upon arrival we will check into our hotel and possibly have time to go to the beach. In the evening we will have dinner at the hotel and talk about the days ahead.

DAY 3

Today you visit Manuel Antonio National Park. With an early morning start your guided walk will give you the opportunity to see 3 species of monkeys, sloths, iguanas, and some of the 350 species of birds that call this place their home. Manuel Antonio is Costa Rica's smallest but most popular park. Its 685 hectares are teeming with wildlife and white sand beaches. We will spend the day in the park with a Picnic lunch and have an opportunity to surf in the afternoon.

DAY 4

After breakfast the day is yours. Hang out at the beach, surf, rent kayaks, return to the park. Your guide will be available for anything you need. Today is a day to just sit back and enjoy.

DAY 5

Today we head back up the coast to La Fortuna, where Costa Rica's most active volcano erupts daily! Upon arrival we will check into the hotel and go to town. In the evening you visit the lovely Natural Hot Springs at Eco-Termals. You will be served a delicious typical dinner after soaking in the waters. Your guide will pick you up and search for a spot to hopefully see lava spewing from Arenal.

DAY 6

In the morning take a guided tour to a stunning waterfall near the hotel. Swim in the clear refreshing pools below. After the waterfall we got on the road and head to the great Caribbean coast where you will settle in for the next few days. We will have lunch on the way. Your guide will take you out your first night in Puerto Viejo to show you the town.

DAY 7

Free day. You have the car and your guide is at your service if need be. If you need activities set up or suggestions on anything you wish will be granted.

DAY 8

Today your guide will meet you at your hotel after breakfast and take you on a guided tour to the Kekoldi Indigenous Reserve near-by where you will meet some of the Indigenous culture and learn about their customs and projects. They have a project to protect the endangered green iguana. A traditional lunch will be served. At night you are welcome to celebrate the New Year with Brian and his friends and family.

DAY 9

It's 2007! Today we celebrate the 1st day of the calendar year by crossing the border into the neighboring country of Panama. After breakfast we head to the border and eventually by way of car and boat arrive to the island of Isla Colon in the Caribbean island chain of Bocas del Toro. We will check into our hotel and your guide will point you to one of the many restaurants built over the clear waters. Isla Colon is the largest island of the chain with all the amenities you may need.

DAY 10

Today your guide has set up a day on the water for you. Starting out with a dolphin tour and then snorkeling and island hopping. You will have lunch on an island and enjoy fresh fish. The evening is yours.

DAY 11

After breakfast we climb into a water taxi, cross the border and return to your hotel in Puerto Viejo, Costa Rica. The afternoon and evening is yours.

DAY 12

A day to do as you please in Puerto Viejo. Your guide again, can set up any tours you may want and you will have the car keys to be mobile.

DAY 13

An early morning pick-up will take you to breakfast and eventually to the banks of the Pacuare river. You will be doing an overnight White Water Rafting adventure on one of the top five rivers on the planet. Expert experienced guides will take you through class 3 and 4 rapids that practically slice through virgin rainforest. The beauty is magical. Your lodging will be luxury camping (beds in spacious tents) and the guides will cook gourmet meals. You will also be served wine or beer with dinner.

DAY 14

After breakfast you will get back on the Pacuare river. You will have lunch on the banks of the river. A transfer will take you to your hotel in San Jose where Brian will be waiting for you with your bags and farewell dinner reservations.
